When you can't find the product you want to buy

^{sumimasen} すみません ^{wa} は ^{dokoni} どこに ^{arimasuka} ありますか? **Excuse me, where is ○○?**



When you want to check the price

^{kore} これ、^{ikura} いくら ^{desuka} ですか? **How much is this?**



^{irasshaimase} いらっしゃいませ
May I help you?

What you'll be asked when paying at the cashier

1. When paying

^{point card} ポイントカードは ^{wa} は ^{o mochi desuka} お持ちですか? **Do you have a points card?**

^{hai} はい、^{arimasu} あります。」 **Yes, I have it.**

^{iie} いいえ、^{arimasen} ありません。」 **No, I don't have it.**

A point card is a card that allows you to accumulate points. When you shop, you receive "points." You can use the points like cash or exchange them for products.

2. You will be asked if you need a plastic bag

^{fukuro wa} 袋は ^{go riyō desuka} ご利用ですか? **Do you need a plastic bag?**

^{hai} はい、^{o nega i shimasu} お願い します。」 **Yes, I'd like a plastic bag, please**

^{irimasen} or 「いりません。」 **No, I don't need a plastic bag.**

3. Choose a payment method
